NOSE

Floral, fragrant and appley with a clear lemon citrus note. Rich peat smoke, hints of wood and vanilla toffee

PALATE

Light floral and fruity with clear peat smoke. Subtle wood note with hints of sweet toffee

FINISH

Peat with fruits – especially lemon, slightly drying wood

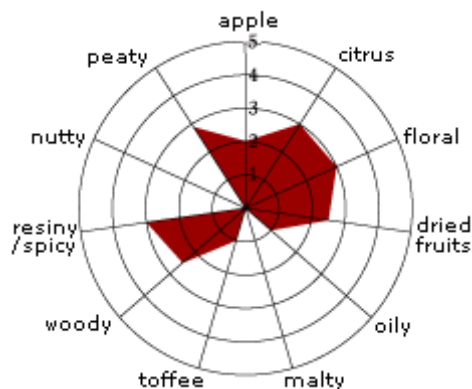

Spider Diagram

The 'Spider Diagram' pictorially represents the unique characteristics of each variant.

It is constructed around 11 flavours and a scale of intensity.

Scale of intensity

0 = absence of flavour
1 = trace of flavour
2 = some flavour
3 = medium flavour
4 = strong flavour
5 = dominant flavour

Flavours

Apple – fresh grapes, cooked apples

Citrus – tangerines, limes, orange peel

Floral – leafy, rose, gorse, bush, geraniums

Dried Fruits – raisins, apricots, mixed peel

Oily – rape seed, linseed, candles

Malty – malt, cereal, biscuity, mealy

Toffee – vanilla, butterscotch

Woody – pine, oak, barbeque, wood smoke

Resinous/Spicy – ginger, cloves, cinnamon

Nutty – marzipan, hazelnuts, olives

Peaty – smoky, incense, TCP, Iodine, phenols
